FIELD NOTES:

About 290 species of birds occur in the Maningrida/Liverpool River region. Many are migrants, with perhaps a dozen rare vagrants boosting numbers in some season.

Several migrating vagrants, mostly waders and seabirds, are sighted along the Arnhem Land coast, islands, and the estuaries, each season.
